**III. CSUSA REPORTS**

1. Mevers Principal Report  
Principal Brenda Coyle reported updates on the CAP and the special education department. Mrs. Coyle also updated the board on the some of the programs and learning techniques, as well as when the first MAP tests would be. Mrs. Coyle shared that she had worked hard on the FY22 budget to ensure there would be money added to the fund balance at the end



of the year. Mrs. Coyle talked about the new staff members; she has brought in for the upcoming year. Ms. Coyle updated the board on how interviews have been going over the summer. Lastly, Mrs. Coyle talked about the projected enrollment for FY22 and what Mevers was doing with Extra Curricular activities, Interventionist and Team Advisors for the upcoming year.

2. Berkeley Preparatory Academy Principal Report

Dr. Roach gave an update on Berkeley Prep. Dr. Roach discussed the different marketing events that are scheduled for BPA. Dr. Roach also shared with the board the success of the July 10<sup>th</sup> Party in the Park event, as well as the first PTC meeting. 3. Grants

Lianne shared that until a new analyst was hired, she would be completing the financials for SC. Corbet Wilson shared that the timing of the physical year end and the grants deadlines. Corbet shared that with the grants the amount of the variance should be better.
