Dr. Weinberg shared with the board about the property and location of the two proposed sites. One site would be in Orangeburg, SC. The property there is being donated by YC Holding company in cooperation with Ben Grambling. This area will be a recreation of the Cane Bay area and the school will be the centerpiece of the subdivision. There are 600 new homes proposed for Phase 1 of this project. The school will be a replica of Mevers School of Excellence. The second site will be in Summerville, SC in the Bacon Bridge Road area.


