Ken Martin, partner with Martin & Smith Company presented the annual audits for BPA and MSE. The audits were done following general audit guidelines. Mr. Martin advised there are strong system controls in place and it's functioning. Detailed testing was conducted and CSUSA staff does a good job providing documents and answers. A modified opinion which is a clean audit used to be called a clean opinion. Finding - Cash balance was large and exceed the FDIC amount. Mr. Martin advised he needed to highlight this to the board. Finding - Financial information had to be formatted to SC chart of account resulting in large amount of audit entries. Stewart requested CSUSA to follow states chart of account and they will be requesting meeting with CSUSA to comply with state chart of account.

• Dr. Todd Trimble State Director Report

To follow up on Brian's request regarding I-Ready Trimble introduced Meredith Ross with CSUSA. Ms. Ross presented I-Ready data for BPA and MSE from 2019-2022.
