Mr Coles updated the board on the meeting with the Berkeley Chief of Police regarding student drop off and pick off. Mr. Coles shared strategies to alleviate traffic issues.

Cheryl shared positive social media highlights she has seen for Mevers and BPA.

 Mevers School of Excellence Principal Report Mr. Coles gave an update on the strategic goals and surveys and shared details from the first two weeks of school. Explained success time and the successful launch of the program. Highlighted upcoming events at the school for the month of September and athletic programs offered at the school. Shared one teacher resigned on the first day of school and teacher vacancies as well as staff updates, recent hires, and enrollment of 984 students. • Berkeley Preparatory Academy Principal Report

Mrs. Bellflower gave an update on BPA strategic goals and survey results. Provided update on the playground and OSF requires an engineer for the projected. It will take ten to twelve weeks to deliver the playground and 7 days to install it. The board requested Mrs. Bellflower share the type of engineer that is needed. Highlighted successes from the first two weeks of school. Provided updates on recent hires, and enrollment of 821 and 269 are waitlisted. Looking at creating a competitive basketball team for the boys this fall. Highlighted upcoming events at the school for the month of September included a blood drive. If 30 people donate, the school will receive \$500.

 Willie Jefferies School of Excellence Principal Report Mr. McGill gave an update on WJSE strategic goals including enrollment outreach and events planned in the coming month. Provided hiring update for this spring. Working on creating a positive community presence. Building will break ground in November. Open enrollment will run from October to February. Finding a transportation solution is still a focus. Introduced Aletha Bryant-Dixon and the positive contribution she has made.

Mrs. Gibson provided grant updates for both MSE & BPA and that the P&I grant is still outstanding for BPA.

Provided class size data and student enrollment data for BPA and Mevers. Both schools have been contacting parents if students have not been attending school. Transportation is the reason why people have withdrawn students. Explained how middle school students do not stay together with their cohort due to each student's ILP.

Mrs. Bellflower shared she has had a meeting with Military Coalition regarding how to better serve military families.
